SYNLAIT POKENO

In 2018 Synlait announced the conditional purchase of land in Pokeno, at the McDonald Road industrial park, to establish a nutritional powder manufacturing site.

Synlait Pokeno, together with Synlait Auckland, form a second integrated processing capability for the company. The integration of these two sites in the North Island creates further supply chain efficiencies and site diversification. Synlait Pokeno collects milk from 64 farmer suppliers which accounts for 14% of Synlait's total supply.

Milk from our Waikato farmer suppliers was first processed at Synlait Pokeno in September 2019 and made into infant base powder and ingredients.

This 24-hours a day, seven days a week manufacturing site employs a team of around 80 highly capable and engaged people and can produce annually up to 40,000 metric tonnes of nutritional powers – including infant grade skim milk, whole milk and infant formula base powders.

Synlait Pokeno continues to grow as we extend the facility to cater to the specific needs of our new multinational customer.

Synlait's Lead With Pride[™] programme recognises and financially rewards suppliers who achieve dairy farming best practice.


