OUR STORY

Synlait was established in Dunsandel, Canterbury in 2000 by Waikato dairy farmers and entrepreneurs Ben Dingle, Juliet Maclean, and Dr John Penno.

At Synlait we combine expert and sustainable farming practices with state-of-the-art manufacturing processes to produce a range of nutritional milk products that provide genuine benefits for human health and wellbeing. Our purpose of *Doing Milk Differently For A Healthier World* is driven by being different, essential nutrition, and sustainability.

Our disruptive, innovative spirit combined with resolute determination to do the right thing for planet and people sets us apart from the competition. Our commitment to elevating people and planet to the same level as profit was recognised in June 2020 when we became part of the B Corp[™] community.

In 2018 Synlait set about establishing a second nutritional powder manufacturing site in the Waikato. Synlait Pokeno, together with Synlait Auckland, form a second integrated processing capability for the company. The integration of these two sites in the North Island creates further supply chain efficiencies and site diversification.



Milk from our Waikato farmer suppliers was first processed at Synlait Pokeno in September 2019 and made into infant base powder and ingredients. This 24-hours a day, seven days a week manufacturing site employs a team of around 150 highly capable and engaged people and can produce annually up to 40,000 metric tonnes of nutritional powers – including infant grade skim milk, whole milk and infant formula base powders.

Today Synlait is building a sustainable, diverse, and recurring revenue base from multiple customers, sites, markets, and categories. It is well positioned to grow earnings off its current asset base, including Synlait Pokeno.



2024 Forecast


- Synlait has forecast for 2023/2024 \$8.00 per kg/MS.
